Mom, son struck by car in North York

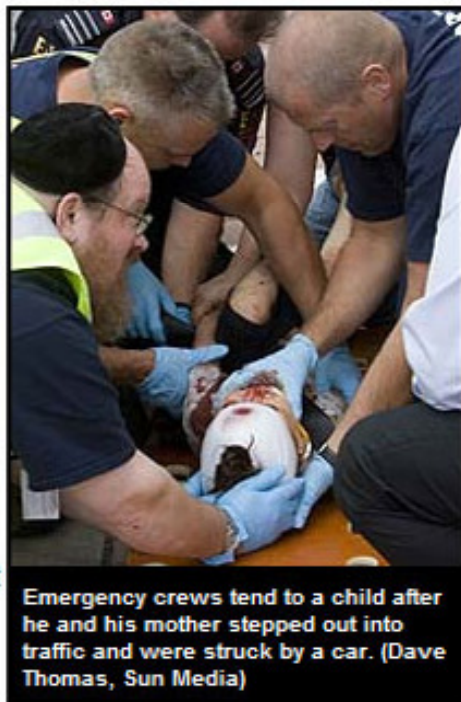
A young boy is in Sick Kids hospital with serious injuries after he and his mother stepped out into traffic and were struck by a car in North York yesterday.

The mother and boy were on the east side of Bathurst, about 30 to 40 metres north of Wilson Ave., when they stepped into the northbound lanes and into the path of a car.

Both the mother and boy, who was not in a stroller, were thrown clear of the car, said Toronto Sun photographer Dave Thomas, who was one of the first on the scene and captured the desperate moments following the accident.

Emergency crews were called to the accident on Bathurst St. at about 2 p.m.

Police from 32 division were unable to provide details of the accident but Thomas said it appeared the mother had struck the windshield after being hit.

The male driver was "devastated and crying", Thomas said. The boy was conscious throughout the ordeal and was screaming before being taken to Sick Kids.

The mother was also taken to hospital.
